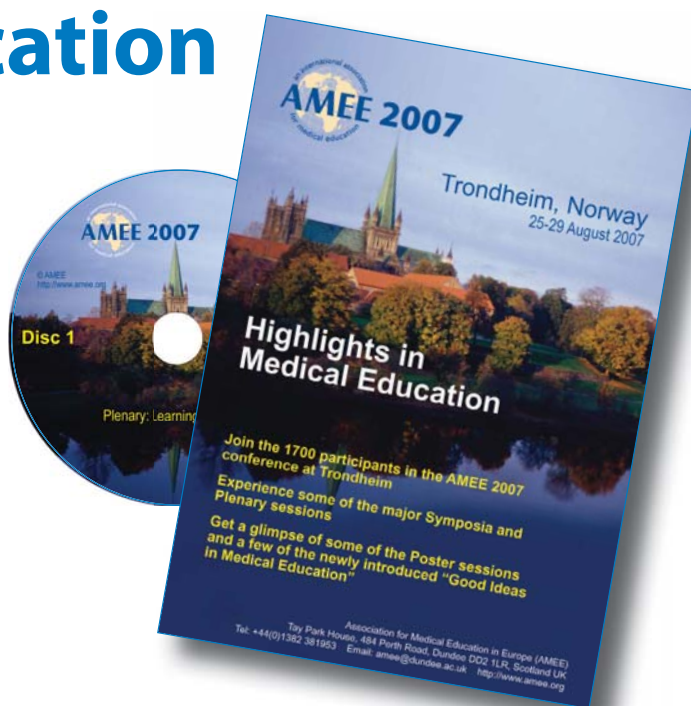


Highlights in Medical Education

The AMEE annual conference is the leading international conference on medical education. AMEE 2007 took place in Trondheim from 25 to 29 August. The conference addressed a wide range of topics in medical and healthcare professions education relating to curriculum planning, methods of teaching and learning including new learning technologies, assessment and education management.
